Don't forget the Tuesday evening MMRG net on 147.000 + 600 with PL of 162.2 hertz.

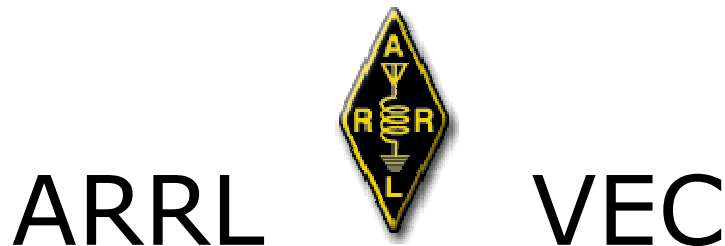
