MAY 7<sup>th</sup>, 2011

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT WERE: BOB SITTERLEY, JERRY ROBERTS, MIKE WILLIAMS, PAT MATTHEWS, PEGGY WILLIAMS, PHIL HAZLETT, SONJA HAZLETT AND LINDA SITTERLEY.

THE ANNUAL PICNIC WAS HELD AT THE HOME OF BOB AND LINDA SITTERLEY IN CHINO VALLEY.

PRESIDENT BOB SITTERLEY K7POF CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 1300.

MINUTES FROM THE MAY 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2010, MEMBERSHIP MEETING WAS READ BY PAT. K7IOG MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES. SECOND BY WA7UID. MINUTES STAND APPROVED AS READ.

## Mingus Mountain Early Morning Net History

### Mingus Mountain Roundtable origin as told by Rocky Fliegel N7UDI

**This started basically as a daily welfare check between Chet Funk K7ZKL (silent key) and myself N7UDI.**

**The wife and I were building a home in Mountainside off the old Senator hwy near Mt. Union.**

**Chet was living in Walker at his cabin 6 months and Phoenix the other 6 months. We were approx. 6 miles apart via Walker Rd. This route was only passable by snowmobile during some of the winter time.**

**I had met Chet thru the Walker Fire Dep't., which I also was part of. I received my ham license in the fall of 1991 at which time, this morning QSO started. This expanded our contact with the outside world, as there were no phone lines available. We met each morning on the Mingus Repeater. I was working on the house alone while my wife worked weekdays in New River. It wasn't long before others started to join in. The regulars at first were Dick Barnes KB7QDY of Cordes Lakes, Don N7QXZ of PV, Joe (silent key) of Cordes Lakes, Chet and myself.**

**Each weekday morning, we talked Dick into work in Prescott, and Don to work. This also involved accident reporting with Az. Highway patrol.**

**During this time, many more joined in when they could, including those that I remember, Walt-WB7CBP, Rex N7NGM Chino Valley, Bill Boggs KD7VLL Seligman, Gary KB7TRC PV, Dave W9KRQ (silent key) and his wife Mary K9MEK. I know I have left some out, but I can't remember names or call signs. I apologize and don't intend to slight anyone.**

**As a side note, in late 91, I also took over the Mingus Tuesday night Net, with Chet filling in. when I wasn't available. I also served on Mingus Mtn. Board for awhile. I continued on this morning Roundtable until June of 2005 when I moved to Nebraska after my wife passed away.**

**Thanks to CQ-100 and Joe -KC7GHT, I am able to check in occasionally.**

I eavesdropped from time to time. Speaking of eavesdroppers here is a list of just a few over the years. KD7AWU, K9MEK, N7SSK, W7POF, AB7NK and many more that are too numerous to mention.

## **From the Registry of Bill KD7VLL**

**About the history of the Mingus Mountain Round table; I'll give it to you as best as memory serves.**

When I first joined the group it was nothing more than 4 guys chatting early in the morning. There was no name for this morning bull session.

There were the following operators at the time that I joined.

1. Chet Funk K7ZKL (Zing King Ling)
2. Rocky N7UDI
3. Walt Nelson WB7CBP
4. Dick KB7QDY? "communications guy for the city of Prescott "
5. Don N7QXZ (a trucker and always mobile)

The group remained pretty well consistent. As memory serves; we heard from Gary...KB7TRC occasionally and then more regularly. The next to join the group as a regular was Dave W9KRQ. About this time Dick KB7QDY dropped out due to a change in working hours with the city.

Some months after Dick had dropped out, Chet became ill. He still maintained the group for a while, but then became too ill to continue. I was filling in for Chet on and off, as his disease progressed. We just called it a Round table. When Chet became ill I took the reins for short time, but being inexperienced at running the Net, I passed it on to Dave seeing he had far more experience. (Besides, he liked the idea; I'm not saying Dave was pushy or anything). (Giggle) "Dave was just set in his ways!

We were growing in membership during this time as Joe Ruby KC7GHT had joined the group as well making all the marvelous connections. You may remember this. Dave W9KRQ was conducting the net every morning at this time. Dave had become ill and turned the reins over to me.

The group has expanded and contracted over time. At present; I have 56 names and call signs on the registry. Many of these people we only hear from occasionally and as infrequently as once a year. The main group as I like to call it; is about 20 operators. The real core group which is almost heard from daily consists of about 11 operators. This varies greatly depending upon who has a cold, sore throat, piles, prostrate troubles, Gout or doctor's appointments, relative barometric pressure, temperature and humidity ( Giggle). Bob K7POF, you and Sherry KF7FVZ, are about the last regulars to join the group. Being a Round table we have all kinds of people come in and out, but perhaps that's what makes it interesting. I personally, try and keep the Round table upbeat or as much as my twisted sense of humor will allow.

As to the history of the original group, before I rejoined, I really don't know that much about. I can remember Chet saying that on the original frequency people had been meeting up every morning for over 20 years. If this is factual or not I really don't know. I believed I joined the original group in about the year 2000 or 2001. It's been so long ago I'm very unsure about the dates. I was talking with Walt Nelson here not to awfully long ago and we were talking about the early days when he introduced me to a small and inconspicuous group, flapping their gums in the morning.

Bob I'm glad you've taken up the challenge of creating a little history for the group. We were just a wandering band of old farts flapping our gums eventually finding a permanent home, with the Mingus Mountain repeater group. I hope this helps you out.
